



Nearby Golf Courses

Mountain Washington Hotel and Golf Club / 25 Minutes Away 278-1000 (Par 72)

27 wide, even, interesting holes. Beautiful view of Mount Washington and the hotel. Good mix of terrain shots. To get there, take Route 18 and turn left onto Route 142 (just before Lovett's Inn) and take this to Route 3. From Route 3, turn right onto Route 302 East (in Twin Mountain) Mount Washington Hotel and Golf Club will be on your left hand side about 8 miles from Twin Mountain.

Sunset Hill Golf Course / 2.5 Miles Away 823-5522 (Par 33)

Although this nine hole course is small it affords some of the best views in the area. This course has no trees and may be good for beginners or as a warm up. Take Route 18 through Franconia Village; take left on Route 117 (Sugar Hill). Turn left at top of hill (Sugar Hill Sampler) onto Sunset Hill Road. The course is on your right.

Lisbon Village Golf Course / 20 Minutes Away 838-6004 (Par 36)

This course is 18 up and down holes along a river valley; Greens and tees are elevated. To get there, take Route 18 through Franconia Village; take left on Route 117 (Sugar Hill). Follow Route 117 to Route 302, turn right here, go over the bridge, then turn left and follow the signs.

Bethlehem Country Club / 15 Minutes Away 869-5745 (Par 70)

This is a lush, scenic, level 18 hole course. A good walking course. Friendly and helpful pro shop. To get there take 93 North and take Exit 40 (Route 302). Take Route 302 east to Bethlehem. Course will be on your left hand side about 2.5 miles from exit 40.

Maplewood Country Club / 20 Minutes Away 869-3335 (Par 72)

This course is very similar to the Bethlehem Country Club course except there are more trees and the holes are a little tighter. Great place to have lunch. To get there, take 93 North and take exit 40 (Route 302). Take Route 302 through Bethlehem. Course will be on your left hand side about 5 miles from exit 40.

Profile Country Club / 10 Minutes Away 823-7083 (Par 36)

This 9 hole course offers spectacular views of Franconia Notch and Mount Lafayette. To get there, take exit 36 on Interstate 93 south, bare left.
