

Local Fishing



The White Mountains region provides clear, cold water that's ideal for trout fishing, with brook trout, brown trout and rainbow trout in abundance. Rivers and streams that are especially notable include the Gale River, Ham Branch River and the Ammonoosuc River. Those who prefer lake fishing can cast a line at Moore Reservoir on the Connecticut River, Echo Lake, Profile Lake (fly fishing only), Coffin Pond and Streeter Pond. The ponds, brooks and rivers of the White Mountain National Forest are also available to fisherman with a network of highways and foot trails offering roadside and backcountry access.

Please note that wherever you fish, including the National Forest, a current New Hampshire fishing license is required for all residents and nonresidents age 16 and older. Minors under the age of 16 years are not required to have a license to fish in N.H. Minors have to be with a licensed adult to fish.
